Hello Wonderful Women of the ELCA,


It has been awhile. We are trying to decide how many Crosswinds we should publish a year. It used to be four but there just isn't enough information that comes in to make four worthwhile.

PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Warm spring greetings to Women of the La Crosse Area ELCA!

Spring is knocking on our door even though it's only March 11! Today's temperatures are AGAIN predicted to be record breaking highs! For anyone out there doubting global warming, please note this: The year 2023 was the warmest year since global records began in 1850 at 1.18°C (2.12°F) above the 20th-century average of 13.9°C (57.0°F). This value is 0.15°C (0.27°F) more than the previous record set in 2016. The 10 warmest years in the 174-year record have all occurred during the last decade (2014–2023). (Source: climate.gov.)

Please make sure the non-perishable food items have expiration dates that are a ways out so they are able to be used at the pantries; expired foods can't be used. The



pantries also need diapers, feminine products, toilet paper, household cleaners, etc.

Items that don't require a can opener and don't need added milk, eggs, and/or butter are most useful.

We are also asking for clean, empty egg cartons. WAFER receives eggs in cases so they need cartons to put the eggs in to give.

1 Peter 4:10: As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

This year, Nominees are needed for the offices of Vice-President, Secretary, East Conference Representative, West Conference Representative, and Board Member-at-Large for full two-year terms. Elections will be held at Spring Convention on April 20, 2024. Below are the job descriptions.

Officers in General

- 1. The officers or leaders of each synodical women's organization may be a president, a vice president, a secretary, a treasurer, a representative from each of the four conferences (North, South, East, and West), and a Board Member-at-Large, herein referred to as SWO leaders. Each shall be a voting member of an ELCA congregation and shall strive to be a participant in a unit.
- 2. These SWO leaders shall be elected by the convention to a term of two years. All shall be eligible for one reelection to the same position.
- 3. Upon completion of her term(s) as president, the president shall be ineligible for election as a SWO leader for two years.
- 4. No elected person shall serve as a SWO leader for more than seven consecutive years.
- 5. Should a vacancy occur among the SWO leaders, the board of the synodical women's organization shall fill the same until the next regular convention. The election by the convention shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term.
- 6. The terms of the SWO leaders shall begin immediately following installation, except that of the treasurer, which shall begin February 1 following election.
- 7. There shall be an executive committee consisting of the president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer, which shall act between meetings of the board of the synodical women's organization.

The Vice President shall

- a. act in the absence, disability, or resignation of the president. She shall assume the duties of that position until the vacancy is filled by the board of the synodical women's organization at its next regularly scheduled meeting; and
- b. perform such other duties as requested by the president of the board.

The Secretary shall

- a. be the secretary of the board and the executive committee of the synodical women's organization;
- b. be responsible for recording and distributing minutes of the synodical convention, the board, and the executive committee;
- c. give the units notification of the regular convention at least three months in advance and of a special convention at least one month in advance;
- d. keep a correct register of the roll of units, along with the names of the officers or leaders of these units;
- e. secure from the units such reports as from time to time may be required;
- f. perform such other duties as the board may from time to time direct; and
- g. provide for the gathering and preserving of historical records and documents.

The Conference Representatives shall

- a. Act as presiding officer of the Conference Committee
- b. Attend Synodical Women's Board meetings as a voting member.
- c. Act as a liaison between the individual units and the Synodical Women's Board.
- d. Work with the Synodical Women's Board and Conference Committee to plan the Fall Renewals.
- e. Plan with the Conference Committee, a special event for conference members. Conference programs could include retreats, a Bible study, a day trip, etc.
- f. Insure any necessary business of the conference is conducted at the Fall Renewal and/or special event.
- g. Submit articles to the synod newsletter, "Crosswinds" as appropriate.
- h. Chair the nominating committee for conference officers.
- i. Compile a notebook of minutes and events to give to your successor at the transition meeting.

The following information is from the W-ELCA Churchwide in Chicago.

WHAT IS AN ACTIVE UNIT?

A unit must commit to four items in order to be recognized as active:

- 1. Come together for study, support, and action.
- 2. Participate in the ministry of W-ELCA beyond the congregation.
- 3. Support financially the total program of W-ELCA.
- 4. Designate leadership that shall be in communication with the synodical and Churchwide women's organization.


